## **AMBITI DI RICERCA**

Mauro Ferrante is Full Professor in Social Statistics at the Department of Culture and Society - University of Palermo. During his career he has published more than 75 papers, many of them in indexed and Class A journals for Competitive Sector 13-D3 (h-index 11 and 590 Scopus citations). He meets all thresholds for the ASN Commissioner requirement. Areas of research concern quantitative methods applied to the social sciences, with particular reference to tourism and health, delving into the topics of statistical surveys (survey methodology) including through the use of GPS technologies, providing methodological insights for the analysis of seasonality and spatial concentration. In the health field, he has worked on indicators for evaluating outcomes, as well as inter-regional mobility including through the use of multi-level models and mediation models. He has over time built numerous international collaborations, also serving as the manager of more than 15 agreements with European and non-European partners. He has been scientific leader of several research projects on issues related to the fields of Social Statistics, supported by national (e.g., PRIN) and international (European Commission) funding, with a total managed funding value of over 300 thousand euros. He is the responsible for the Department of Culture and Society for Social Impact Analysis of social projects funded by external agencies, such as Fondo Beneficenza Intesa San Paolo and Impresa Sociale con I Bambini.

He has been Visiting Professor at the University of Seville and the University of Dubrovnik and has been a Visiting Researcher in Austria (WIFO) and at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (USA). He is a member of editorial boards of indexed scientific journals and serves on the Editorial Review Board for the top journal *Annals of Tourism Research*. He was co-editor of a volume published in the Springer International Series - *Advances in Spatial Science*, and guest editor of a Special Issue in the journal *Regional Science Policy and Practice* of the Regional Science Association. He consistently serves as a referee for leading journals in the fields of tourism and social and regional sciences (e.g., *Tourism Management*, *Current Issues in Tourism*; *Social Indicator Research*; *Papers in Regional Science*, *Journal of Regional Science*, *Applied Geography*; *Regional Science Policy and Practice*; *Tourism Economics*; *Journal of Sustainable Tourism*). He has coordinated teams for research activities, also serving as mentor for research grants, fellowships and numerous collaborative contracts.

He has promoted the University of Palermo abroad both through active participation in international research networks and through the organization of workshops and incoming activities of scholars of relevant international prestige as part of seminar and teaching activities for Ph.D. and master's degree programs. He has been a member of doctoral committees in Italy and abroad. He has received several awards for scientific activity, serving as invited speaker and keynote speaker at workshops and conferences nationally (e.g., University of Bolzano; SIEDS; ISTAT) and internationally (e.g., Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Jönköping University - Sweden, Modul University of Wien; Uppsala Universitet - Sweden). He has been teaching in the field of Social Statistics for more than 15 years, in three-year, master's and PhD programs, in Italy and abroad, and has carried out numerous institutional activities in support of Courses of Study (ex. QA Committees, Joint Committees, responsibility for Erasmus agreements), of the Department (Delegation for research projects and administrative simplification, QA Research Commission, Internationalization Commission, Departmental Council), and at the University level (PRIN Project Evaluation Committee; University Working Group for VQR support activities).
